1. Bridge Course:

Bridge course is conducted every year in the beginning of first year. The bridge course objective is to polish the prerequisite knowledge such as basic of English language and computer operation proficiency. At the start of the MCA program, before commencement of the First semester students undergo bridge courses in which basics about course is explained. MCA 1st year students coming from non-computer background are introduced by improving logic and core programming languages. It is expected that the students should know basics of all the subjects what they are expected to study

2. Fundamental Subject workshop

The objective of this mini project is to let the BCA, BBA,BMS, MCA and MCA (Integrated) students apply the programming knowledge into a real- world situation/problem and exposed the students how programming skills helps in developing software projects. Each student has one project guide which is allotted by mini project coordinators. The project guide keeps track of project development activities along with solving the critical queries of students regarding software project. This program helps students to get the overall programming experience which can be utilized in interviews and placement process.

1. Remedial Coaching :

Subject wise remedial coaching is provided to all students who failed in university exams. The objectives are to give special attention to the problems of slow learners, to improve academic performance of the slow learners, to avoid the dropout ratio. It becomes difficult to stop the drop out when slow learners are not paid proper attention in their academic life. As an essential part of educational pedagogy and educational psychology, slow learners should be diagnosed with their problems and should be provided with proper remedies. Considering this vital fact, institute has taken effective initiative to stop the drop out by bringing slow learners in the main stream of academic life. It is regular academic process of the institute to facilitate slow learners with remedial coaching related to difficult topics from the curriculum.. It helps in their comprehension of overall curriculum. Remedial Coaching is provided free of cost to the slow learners irrespective of their social and financial status. Home assignments are also arranged by the faculty members for the students to bridge the knowledge gap & enable them to cope with the academic course to which they are enrolled. Faculties are available beyond class hours and during vacations for academic interaction. Remedial coaching classes are completed before the commencement of exams. Model question papers are solved by the students with the help of respective faculties.

2. Retest:

After result of internal exam, failed students are identified and subject wise retests are conducted for such students.

3. Peer-group learning:

Peer-group learning method is applied where both the slow and advanced learner students are combined together for understanding of particular subject, topic assignment.
