All the IMRD teaching and non teaching faculties gave their best support to make this event successful.



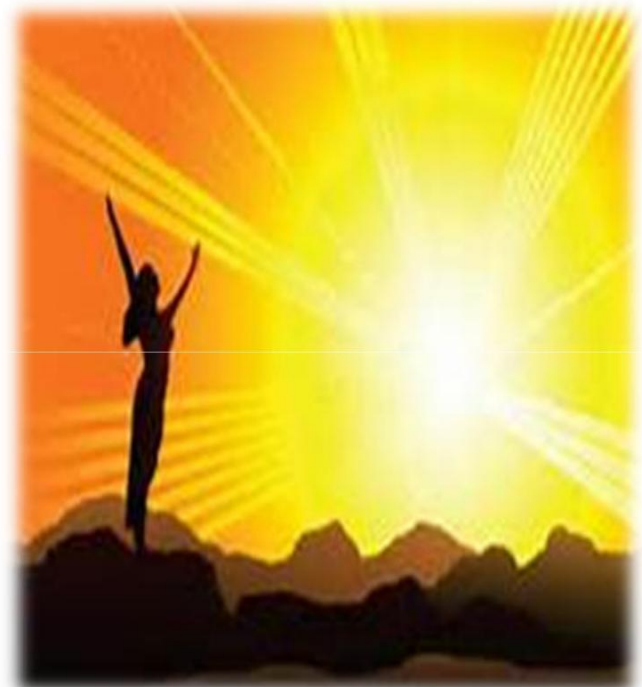

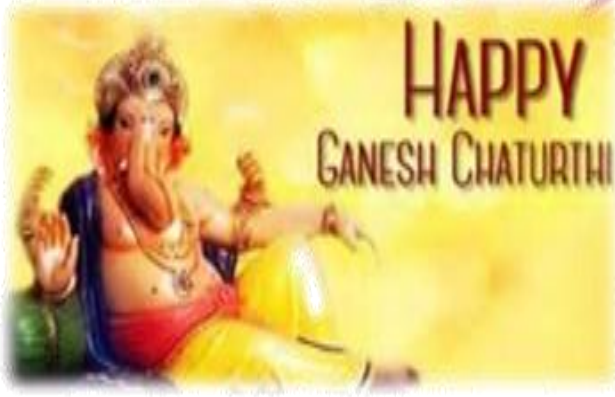

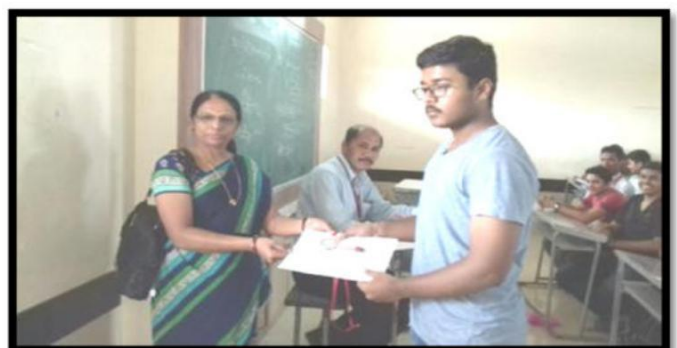

For this workshop all the MCA faculties gave their support to make this event successful.



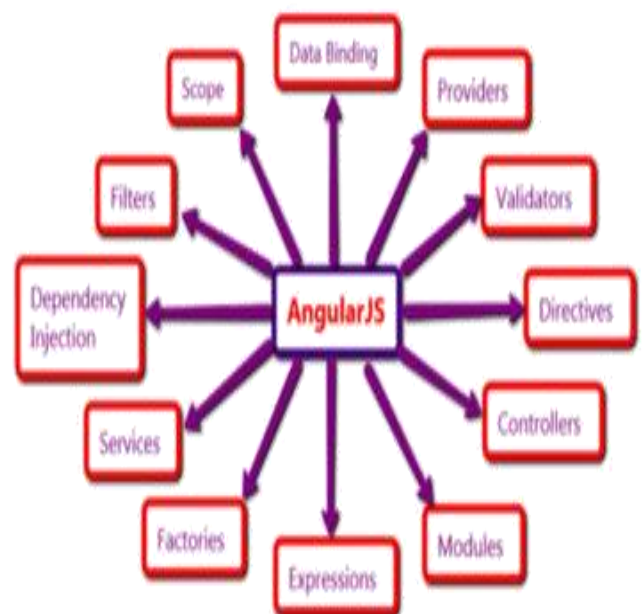

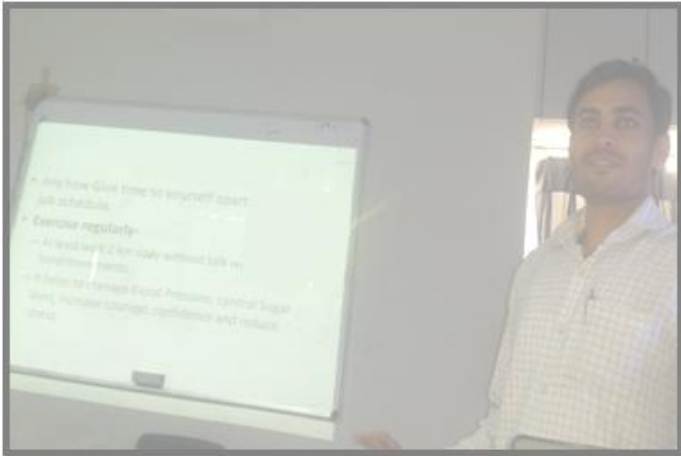
