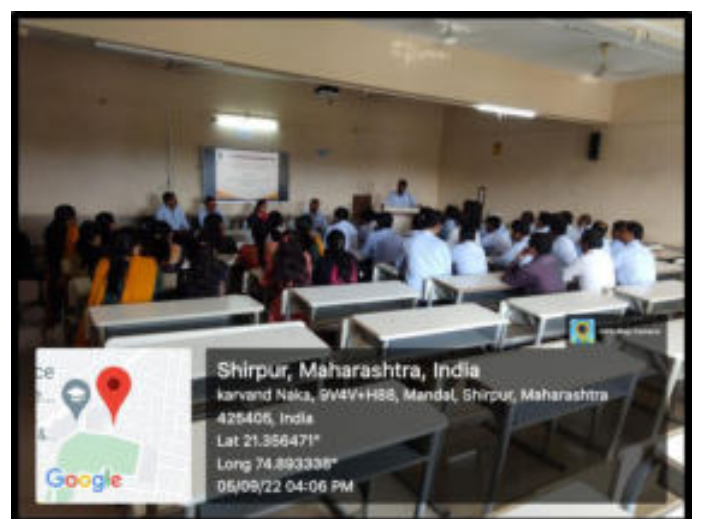

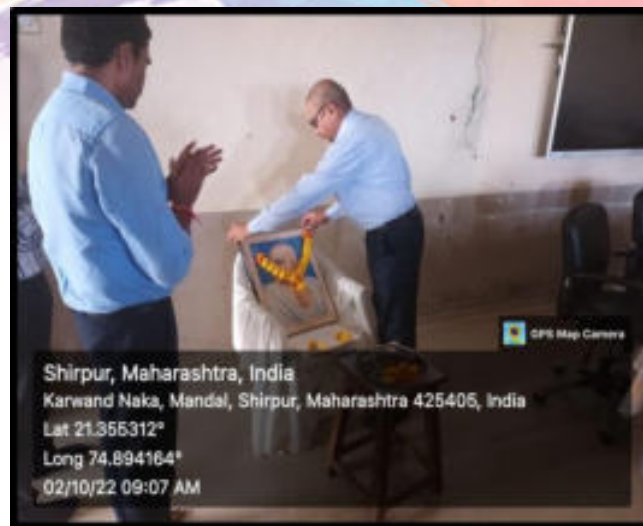

In this Webinar Prof. Sweta Dargad covered following topics:

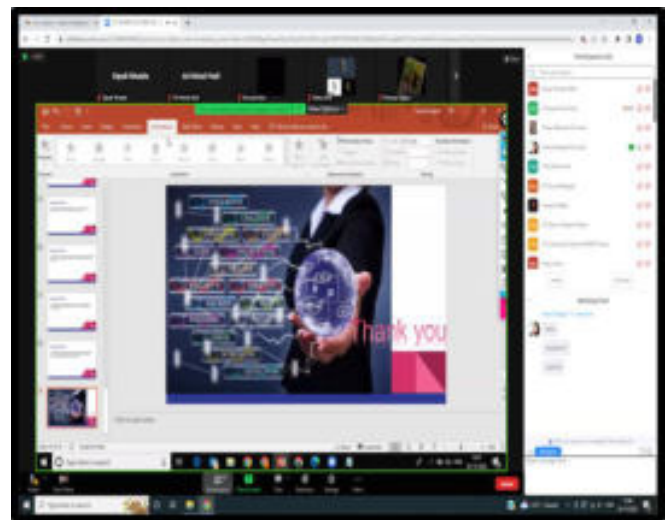
- Think before post on social media

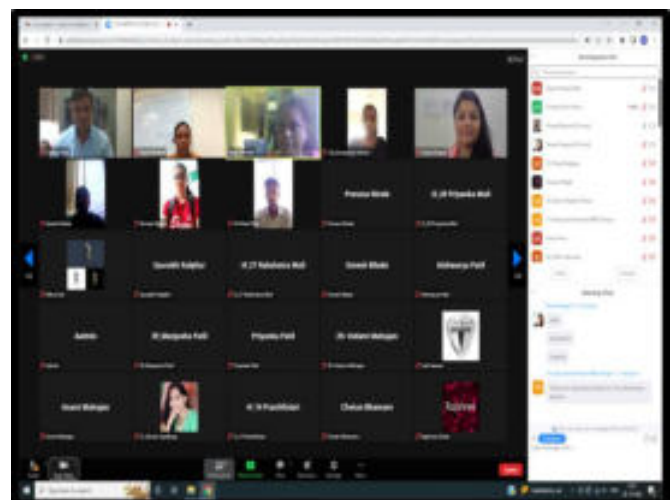

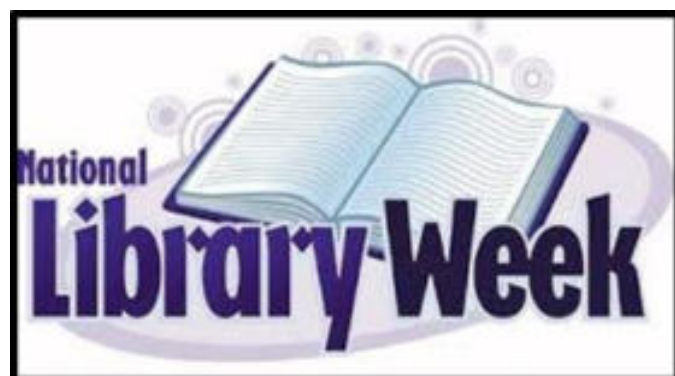
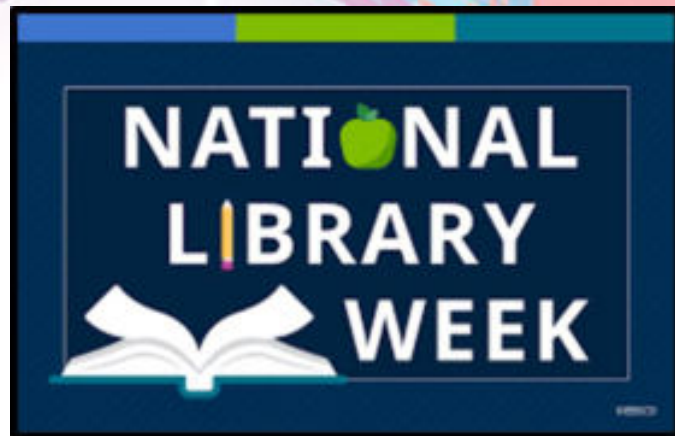


National Library Week: Book Reading Campaign
