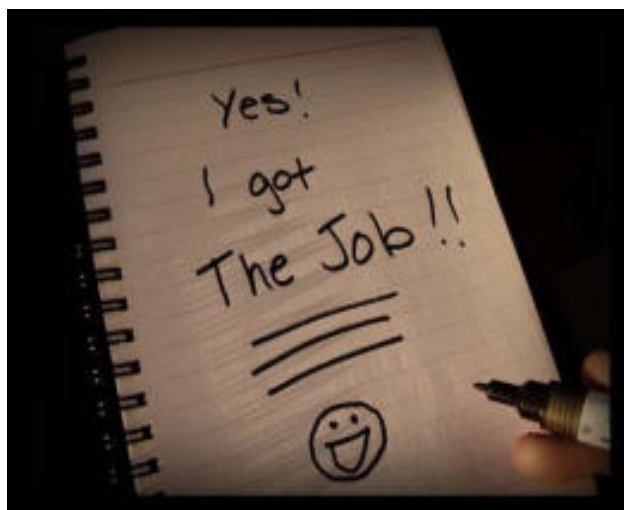

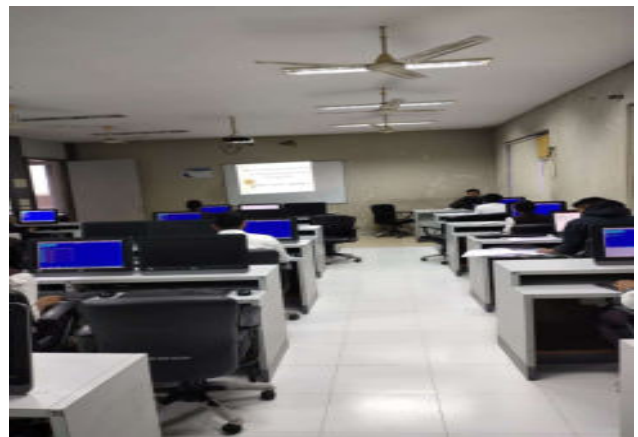
C-Language Programing Contest

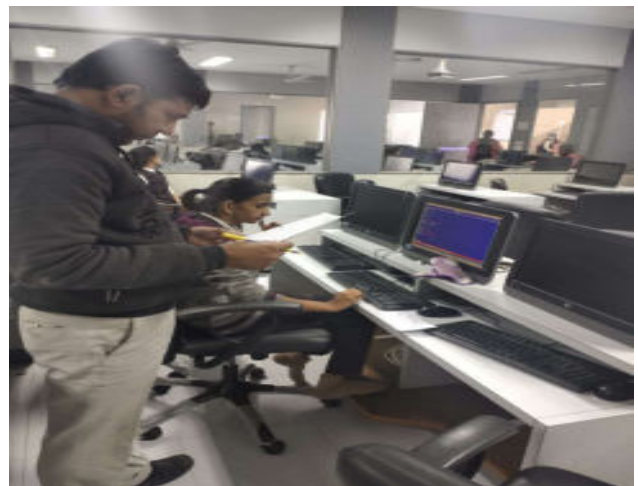

Mr. S. K. Bide and Mr. J. E. Rajput judged this competition. Out of 20 participants 3 winners were selected and awarded.

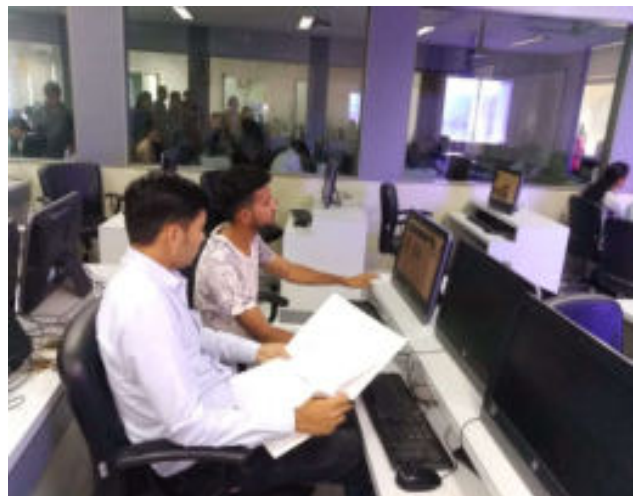
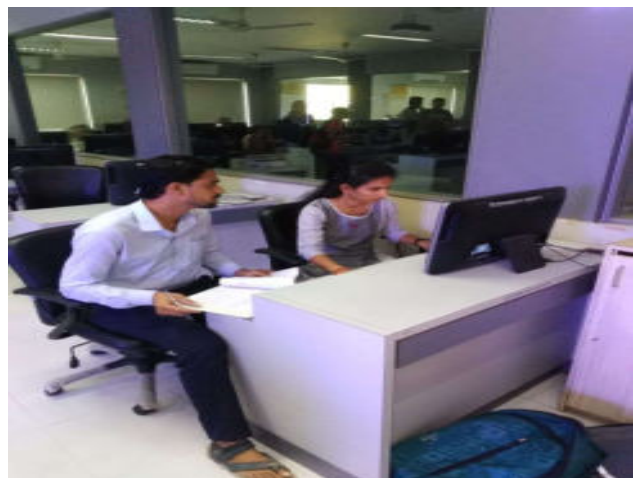
