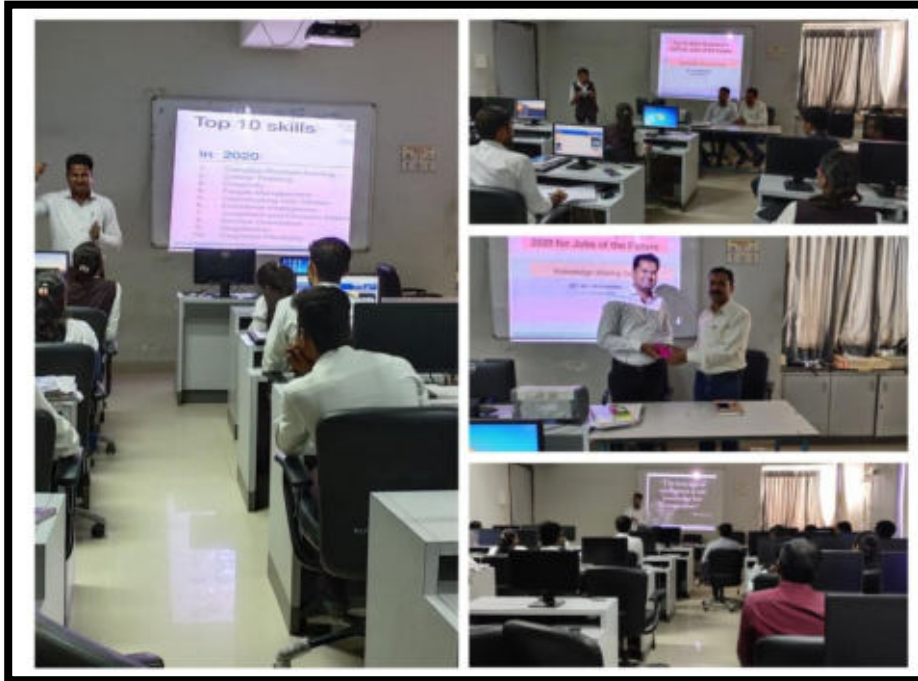

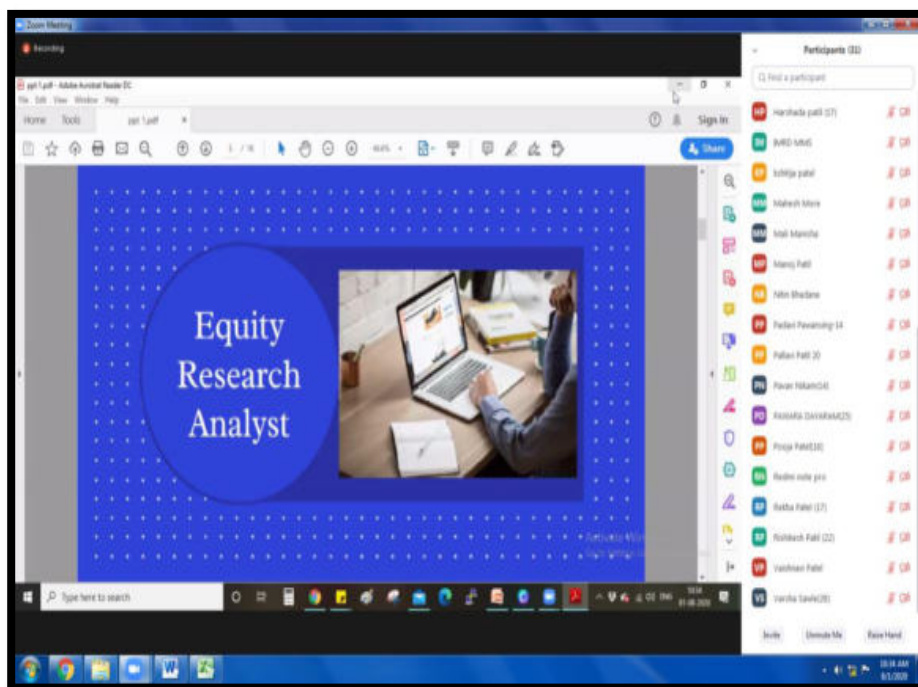


5. Online Webinar on “Career Guidance and Opportunities during and Post COVID - 19

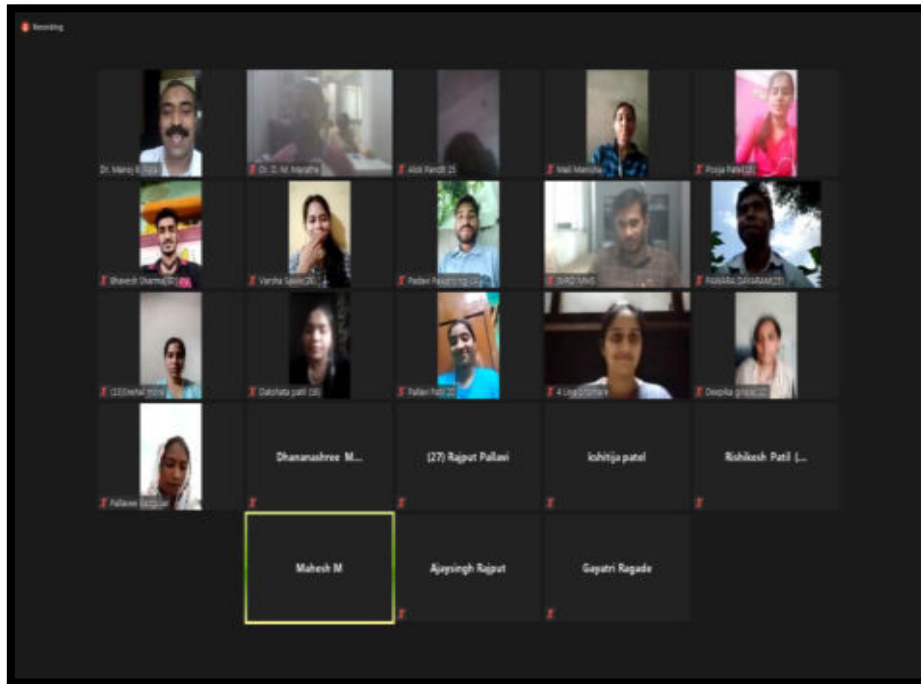

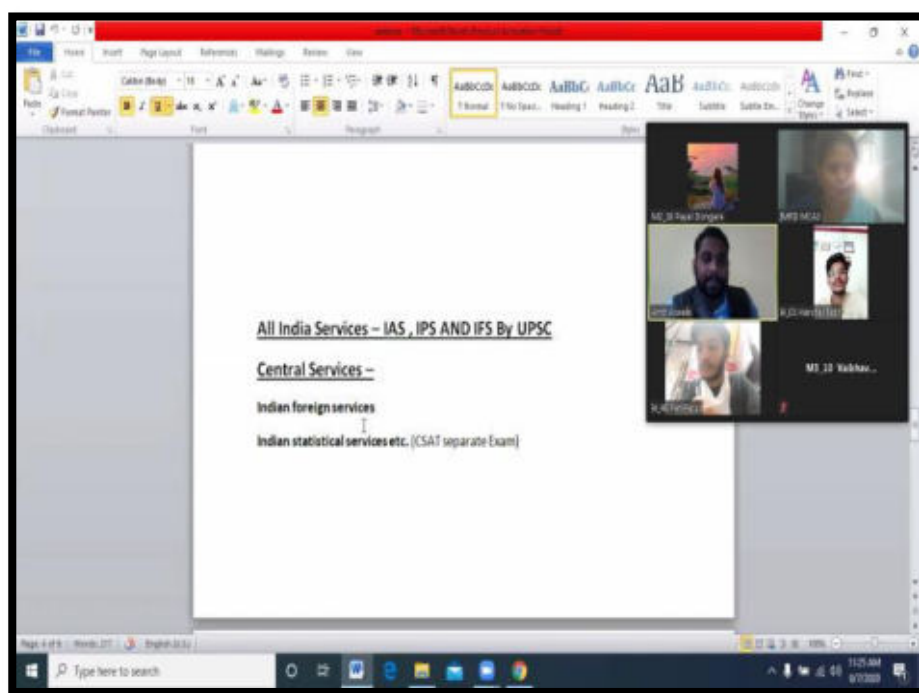


6. Online Webinar on Competitive Examinations Guidance - “A Game Changer”

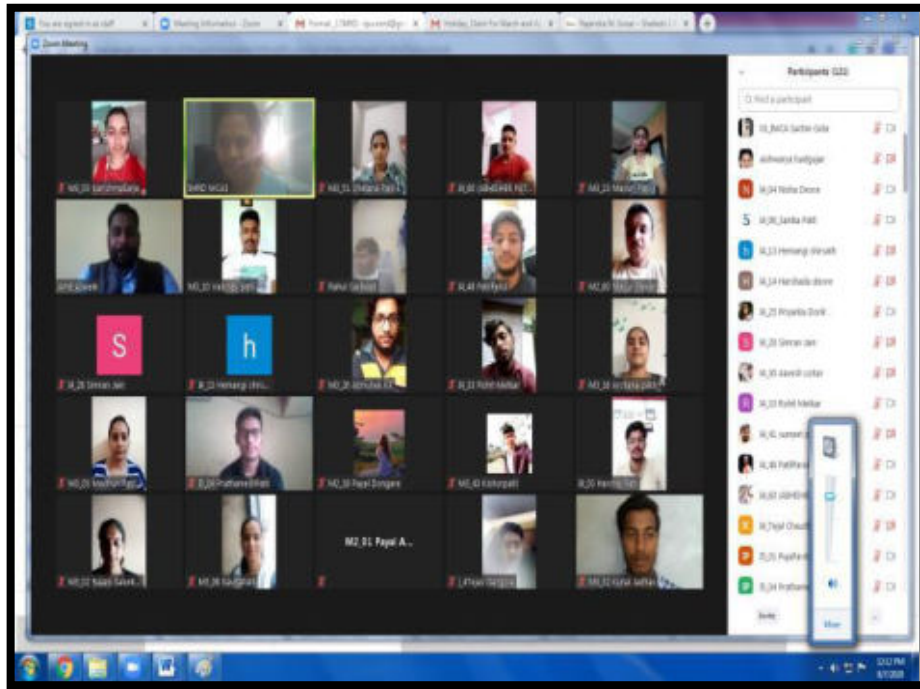

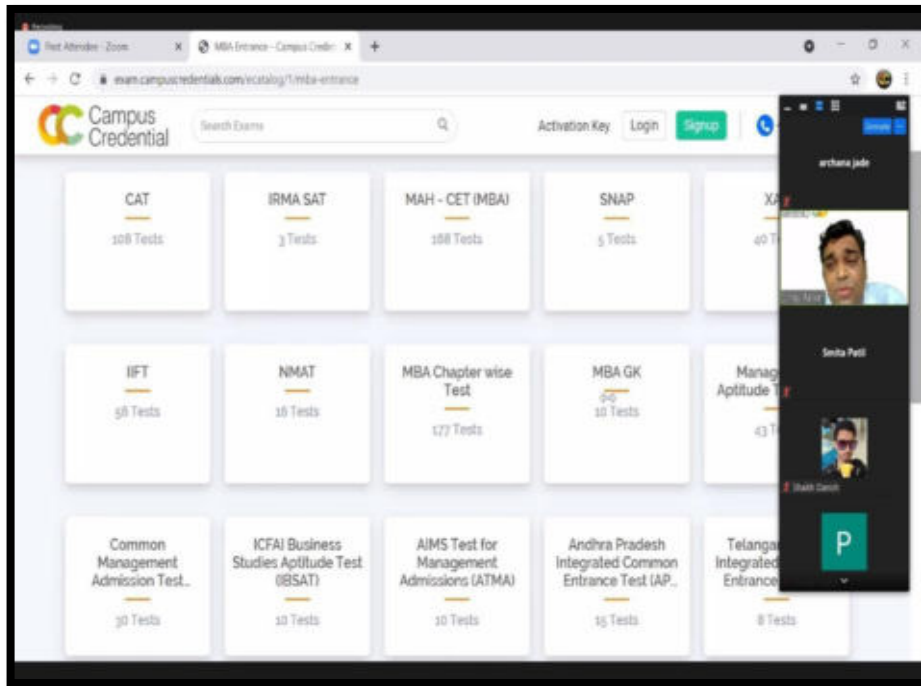
2. MBA Career Guidance Webinar for BBA and BMS Final Year Students.

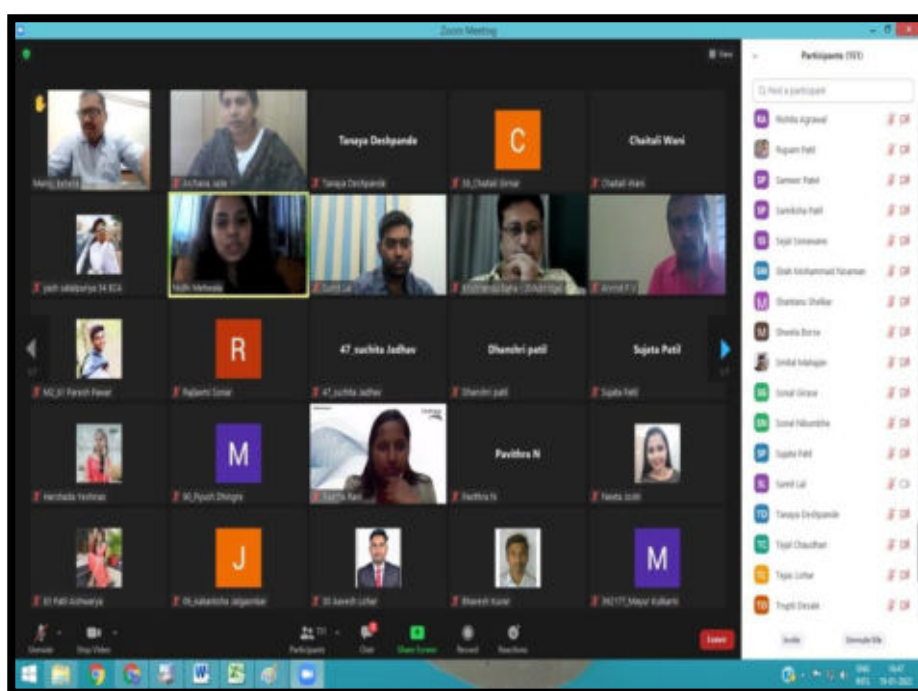

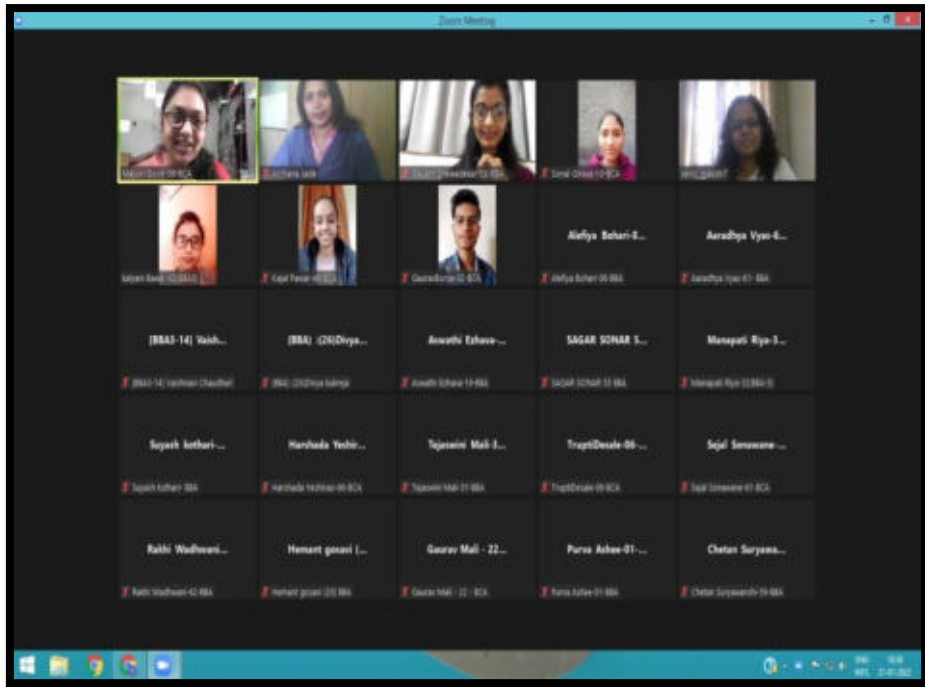

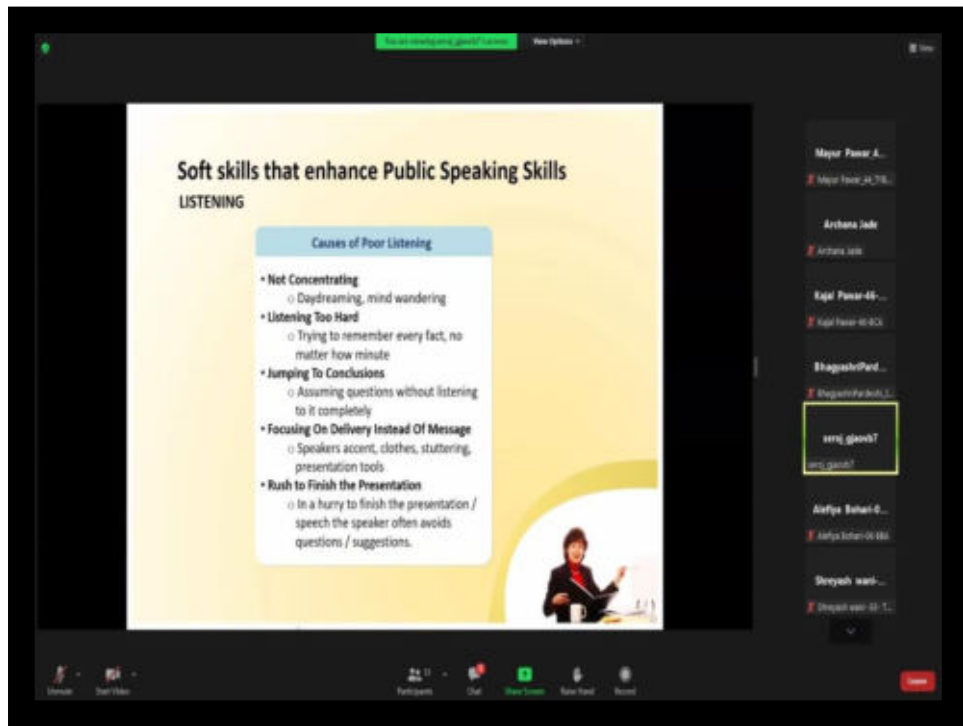

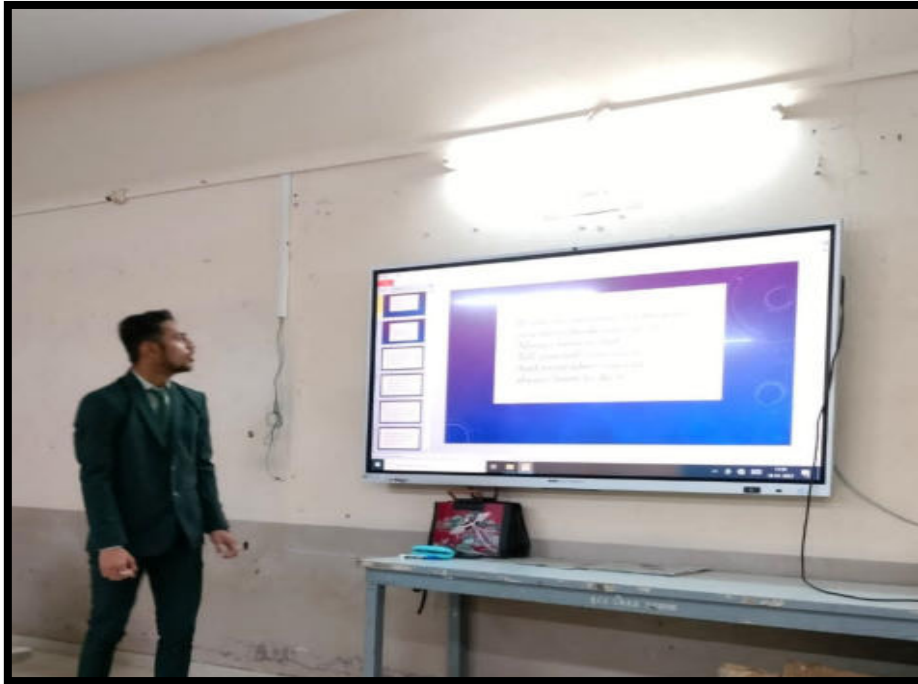
