














3.2. Meditation by students during the exam

- Stack, Queues






2. Webinar on Parallel Computing





3. Online Webinar on Current IT Trends



In this webinar madam focused on:






7. Webinar on Wireless Sensor Networks










11. Pre-IT Workshop for MCA and IMCA

The main objectives of the webinar was:






14. Online E-Resources Awareness Program (UG)






1.2 MBA Career Guidance Webinar for BBA and BMS Final Year Students.






1.5Webinar by EduBridge in association with Capgemini and AWS







2. Soft Skills and Communication Skill







4.2 Webinar on Robotic Process Automation










In this Webinar Prof. Sweta Dargad covered following topics:
